OUR GRAND MASTER

M.W. BRO. DONALD A. CAMPBELL,



M.W. Bro. Donald A. Campbell was born and educated in Niagara Falls. He holds a BAA in Justice Studies from Guelph University, and is an Honours graduate of the Police Foundations Leadership program at Humber College. He has also graduated from other law enforcement institutions including the FBI National Academy in Virginia, and the Canadian Police College in Ottawa. Currently, he is a 38 year member with the Toronto Police Service, serving at the rank of Superintendent.

Our Grand Master comes from a long line of Masons. He was initiated into and is an honorary life member of Scarboro Lodge No. 653, Scarborough, serving as the Worshipful Master in 1987. He is a member and Past Master of Heritage Lodge No. 730, Cambridge, and along with his father (Stanley) and brother (Robert), is a member of King Edward VII Lodge, No. 471, Niagara Falls. Grand Master is also a member of various other lodges and concordant Masonic bodies including Scottish Rite, Royal Arch Masons and the Rameses Shrine Temple.

OUR DISTRICT DEPUTY GRAND MASTER

R.W. Bro James G. M. Lawson



R. W. Bro. James G. Lawson was born and raised in Paisley Scotland. After completing high school he trained with Chrysler U.K. as a Production Engineer. During this time his family emigrated to Canada, while he remained in Scotland to complete his studies. Also during this time he was to meet and marry his lovely wife Jane in October 1972.

On November 19, 1972 he and his wife emigrated to Canada and lived in Etobicoke before settling in Mississauga in 1975 where they reside today, as empty nesters. Since his arrival in Canada he enjoyed a successful career in engineering and in 1988 was accepted into the Faculty of Education at the University of Toronto. He graduated with his teaching credentials and taught for the Peel District School Board until he retired.

Initiated Passed and Raised in Mississauga Lodge No. 524 in 1982. He became an officer in 1983 and progressed to be W. Master in 1991. After completing the offices of IPM and Director of Ceremonies he became Treasurer in 1994 and remained Treasurer until December 2005.

In 2001 - 2002 he served as District Secretary of Toronto District No. 1 Now Toronto West District. In the years 2008, 2009 and 2010 he once again served his Lodge as Junior Warden, Senior Warden and W. Master.

In 2010, when he vacated the Master's chair he once again became Treasurer where he remained until being elected as District Deputy Grand Master of Toronto West District in July 2014.

THE TEMPLE (THE OLD CHURCH)

The building was erected in 1838 as a Wesleyan Methodist Church through the combined efforts of the settlers and the Mississauga Indians. All the labour and most of the material was local. It was the Mission House where Rev. Peter Jones, himself a Mississauga Indian, and Rev. Egerton Ryerson held services. The Church faced the Lakeshore Road where the present Chapel of the First United Church now stands. In 1894, after serving as a Church for over fifty years, it was sold to a Mr. Shaw who had it moved intact to a site a few feet west of its present location. Here, for 20 years, it was rented out as a community hall.

Late in 1914, the building was purchased by the Mississauga Masonic Corporation to be used as our Masonic home. Extensive renovations were made from time to time. In 1926, the present basement was dug and the building set over it. At the same time extensions were added front and rear to give the present overall floor space. The latest renovation was in 1963.

In order to preserve and modernize the old structure, the exterior walls and wood were renewed, the interior panelled, indirect lighting added, as well as a new carpet. Now only the shell of the original building remains, hidden in the walls and attic. It is most gratifying to find with all the modernizing, that the Lodge Room retains the warm friendly atmosphere of the past. The furniture is also old in keeping with the Temple. It was first owned and used by Ashlar Lodge, Toronto in 1878. The two tracing board oil paintings are the work of Ashlar's Junior Warden in 1879. When Ashlar Lodge moved into the Yonge Street Temple, the furniture and paintings were no longer needed and were purchased by Mississauga Lodge in 1914.

Other items of furniture and equipment have been donated through the years by Mississauga brethren and by brethren of other lodges. They are too numerous to mention here, but their names are recorded in the Archives.


